- Containers leaking unknown substances
- Propane cylinders
- Gas cans, oil or anti-freeze
- Paint cans
- Pesticide or herbicide containers
- Automotive batteries
- Weapons
- Narcotics
- Dead animals
- Broken glass

DO'S

- Wear gloves
- Wear good closed-toe walking shoes
- Wear bright-colored clothing
- Dress for the weather
- Frequently observe traffic
- Monitor approaching vehicles
- Supervise children at all times
- Post photos with #SimplyProud
- Have fun!

DONT'S

- Pick up litter on roads
- Ignore traffic
- Wear flip-flops or sandals
- Pick up litter with bare hands
- Stray from assigned litter zone
- Run near roadways
